## **ORDINANCE NO. 387**

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING CAPS ON CLEAN OUT PIPES CONNECTED TO THE PLUMBING OF RESIDENCES OR BUSINESSES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF THAYER, KANSAS SEWER SYSTEM AND PROVIDING A \$50 FINE PER DAY FOR VIOLATIONS AFTER FEBRUARY 1, 2022

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Thayer, Kansas:

SECTION 1: Thayer has an interest in maintaining its sewer system within its City limits.

**SECTION 2.** Citizens and business owners shall be required to make sure that the clean out pipes coming from their homes or business buildings have a clean out cap installed on them by February 1, 2022.

SECTION 3. Failure to do so by February 1, 2022 may result in a fine of \$50 and an additional fine of \$50 per day thereafter the initial fine per residence or business building,

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on February 1, 2022, and after its adoption and publication once in the Chanute Tribune newspaper, as provided by law.
