Discussion –

Charles Blackburn –

Mr. Blackburn was in attendance to explain his water leak. Mr. Blackburn says it is the City's responsibility after the meter was put in incorrectly 50 years ago, and the pipe that the house connects to (where leak happened), is the city's. Although it has been said previously if the meter is turned off and the leak stops, the leak is on the occupant's side. The City will do more research and table to April regular meeting.

City Growth Plan –
