Discussion –

Fire Department – The bill came in for work done at the fire department, totaling \$5,707.45. Chief Trout to have paid by the wind farm extra funds given to fire department.

Hicks Bill – Greg would like the city to pay for half of the water line addition work done by Tim Morris. Council provided insight on the city ordinances, and denied to pay half.

City Growth Plan – Dusti will be scheduling a date to have Ranson Financial come and talk to council/Dusti. Other things discussed was security systems, materials in the City Shop and storage, gazebo at the park, City signage, handicap dock, old funnel cake stand at park, parking bumpers, amateur hour, City accounts, trash barrels, etc.
